

PERMISSION TO DRIVE

Students are encouraged to use the transportation provided by the school district while attending school but may drive when the need arises providing their parents or guardian sign the "Permission to Drive" slip.

Students should park their vehicles in the school parking lot near the stadium. A tag will be issued and a spot assigned. The parking pass must be visible on the rear view mirror with the tag number shown. Students must park in the assigned spot. Failure to do so will result in a loss of driving privileges for three (3) days. A second offense will result in a loss of driving privileges for two (2) weeks.

A student may not transport another student without written permission.

Students driving to school may not interfere with the movement of busses. Students who reside near Sidman should exit the top of the lot. Students living towards St. Michael should exit the lower end of the lot.

Students are not permitted to leave school once they are on school property unless properly excused. Students who drive to school may not loiter in the parking lot, they should enter the building immediately.

The student parking lot is an extension of the Forest Hills Junior-Senior High School. Students who are granted the privilege of parking in the parking lot must understand that, on occasion, their vehicle may be subject to a canine sniff search. Completing and signing the Forest Hills Junior-Senior High School Permission to Drive Form, in essence, will grant the School District the right to randomly conduct sniff searches in identified vehicles. Students and parents must understand that these identified vehicles will be subject to search by school administrators and legal authorities, to include, but not limited to the police.

Students are advised that they must adhere to and obey all appropriate driving rules and regulations as set forth by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania while on all school grounds. This includes stop signs, use of turn signals and driving at safe speeds for existing conditions. Violators may be cited by the local police.

Students must present a valid driver's license to be copied and kept on file prior to receiving an assigned parking space.
