Since the weekend, the Forest Hills Elementary School and the Forest Hills Junior-Senior High School have recorded confirmed positive cases of COVID-19. The reported cases have been identified, impacted individuals have been isolated, and all contact tracing has occurred. Currently, the reported numbers are within the limits for both schools to remain in the current face-to-face traditional instructional model. Be advised that the District is working with the Pennsylvania Department of Health and other public safety experts to ensure the health and safety of the Ranger community.
