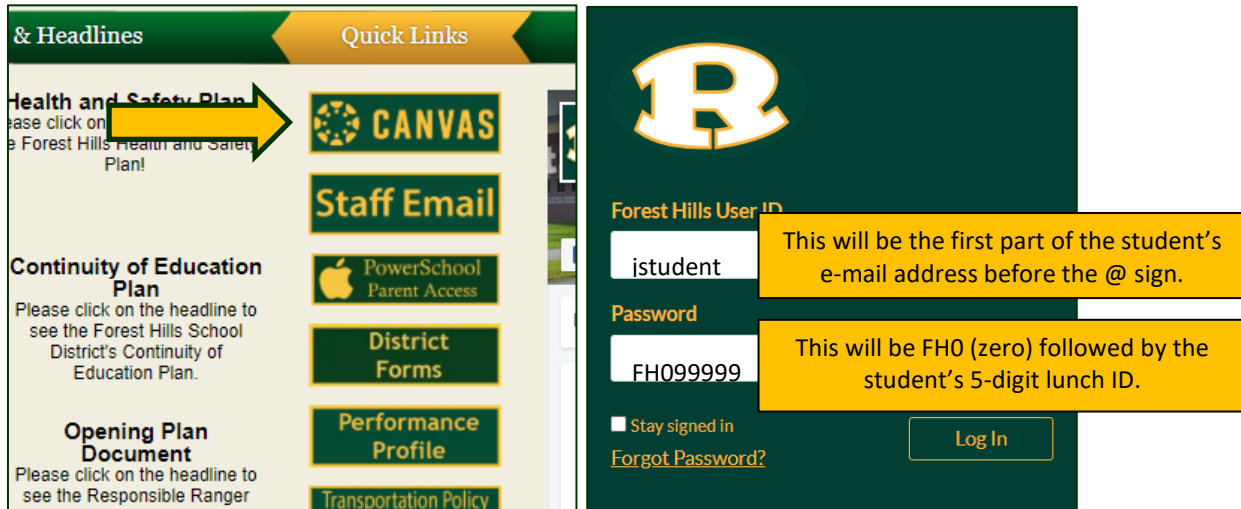


Canvas at Forest Hills

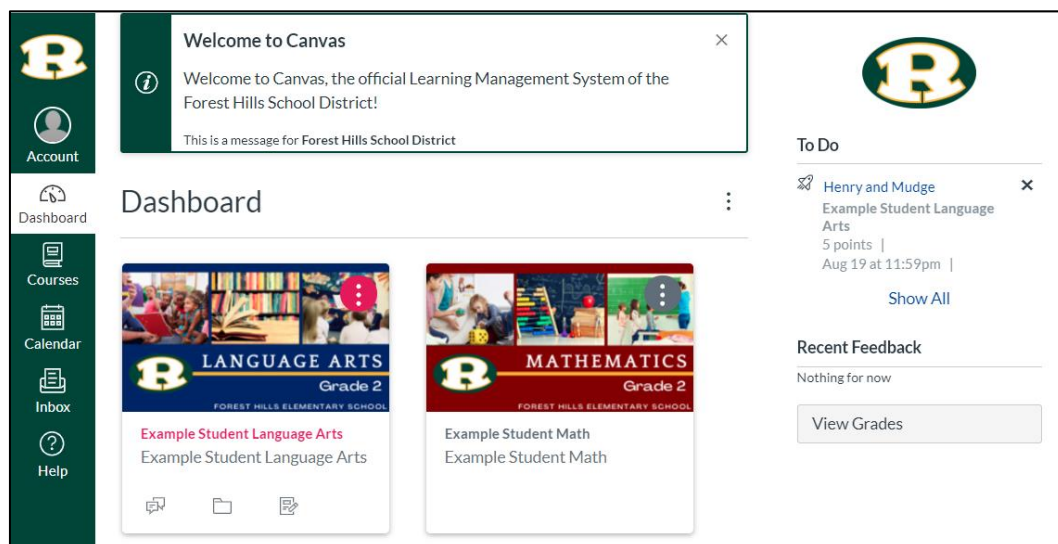
Forest Hills School District has adopted a powerful new tool to support teaching and learning beginning this fall. The Canvas Learning Management System (LMS) is an Internet-based platform that provides a framework and tools to facilitate learning both inside and outside of school. Canvas makes it easy to provide access to class materials, assignments, schedules, communication tools, feedback, analytical data, and more—while keeping everything simple, easy, and in one place. Canvas was chosen for its wide range of easy to use tools for teachers, students and parents.

To login to Canvas:

1. Navigate to the **Forest Hills School District Website** at <https://www.fhrangers.org/>
2. Select the **Canvas** button from the **Quick Links** menu.
3. Enter your Forest Hills **User ID** and **Password** into the spaces provided. Then click **Log In**.



4. The next screen is called **The Dashboard**. This helps the student see what is happening in all of his or her classes. The Dashboard displays
 - a. a Course Card to access each of the student's courses (center)
 - b. district-wide Announcements related to academics (at top)
 - c. the To Do list, upcoming events, and access to Grades. (at right)
 - d. access to system-wide tools and to Canvas Help. (at left)



5. Click on any **Course Card** to enter the course. Then, click the buttons on the home page to view materials.
6. Click the **Dashboard** button on the left panel to return to the Dashboard and switch to another class.
7. Click the **Account** button at the top of the left panel and select **Logout** to leave Canvas.
