Dear Ranger Family,

These have been very difficult days for all of us. I appreciate your patience and understanding as we navigate these most challenging times in the face of a national pandemic and state of emergency. In addition to the information that was shared earlier, the Pennsylvania Department of Health has confirmed two (2) additional cases of COVID -19 at the Elementary School. No additional cases have been reported at the Junior-Senior High School. With these facts in mind, and following guidance from the Pennsylvania Department of Health, the following actions will occur:

- On Thursday, October 15, 2020, the Junior-Senior High School will return to in-person learning. Be advised that all students identified as being in the quarantine protocol will remain in quarantine until that period has passed.
- Junior-Senior High School extra-curricular activities will resume on Thursday, October 15, 2020. The advisors, coaches, principals, and the athletic director will share additional information regarding schedules.
- The Elementary School will remain in remote learning up to and including Wednesday, October 21, 2020.
- On Thursday, October 22, 2020, the Elementary School will return to in-person learning. Once again, any student or staff member placed in the quarantine protocol may not return to school until the quarantine period has passed.
- The spectator policy during this quarantine period will be limited to two (2) tickets per participant, and the senior participants will utilize their previously issued passes.

Students who are actively in quarantine protocol will receive education through the use of the Canvas Learning Management System. For your convenience, the District's parking lots have wireless access points for the internet. If you would like to utilize these access points, please visit the school parking areas after 4:00 PM.

Meals will be made available for families under the quarantine protocol and during remote learning. This distribution will occur on Monday, October 19, 2020. The Distribution point will be at the established location at the Junior-Senior High School Auditorium entrance. A [Quarantine/Remote Learning Meal Pick-Up Survey](#) has been placed on the District website for families to register for the meal distribution program. Families will be eligible for a week's worth of meals.

We understand that these are extremely challenging times for all Rangers. Thank you for your help as we navigate these most stressful times. Please be observant of the current hygiene, social distancing protocols, and protective face covering requirements. Stay healthy and safe, Forest Hills!
