Dear Ranger Community:

This past weekend, the Forest Hills School District was notified of confirmed positive cases of COVID-19.

In an effort to provide each of you with up-to-date information in a transparent manner, the following represents the latest cleaning and sanitation protocols to provide a safe and healthy learning environment for all students and staff members within our school district buildings.

Each of the school buildings received a thorough deep cleaning by our maintenance and custodial staff throughout this past weekend. In addition, both of the buildings received another thorough cleaning today, Monday, February 22, 2021.

Due to the weekend break and today's virtual learning day, along with the combined efforts of our staff to conduct the deep cleaning protocols, the number of confirmed positive cases does not exceed the number of cases to force a closure of the buildings and move to several days of remote learning.

The District will continue to work with PA Department of Health officials in identifying all individuals who had close contact with the person(s) who are positive for COVID-19. Close contact is defined by medical experts as being within six (6) feet for fifteen consecutive minutes or more of the individual who tested positive for COVID-19.

In addition, all Rangers will need to continue to follow the basic personal hygiene protocols that have been set in place by the health officials. These protocols include, but are not limited to, wearing a protective face covering, washing hands frequently, staying home when you are ill or experiencing flu-like symptoms, and reporting COVID-19 and/or positive COVID-19 test results to school officials.

Our highest priority is the safety of our students, staff and community members. Rest assured, we will remain vigilant in the following health and safety protocols in order to remain open for face-to-face instruction.

We are grateful for your continued support of the Forest Hills School District.
